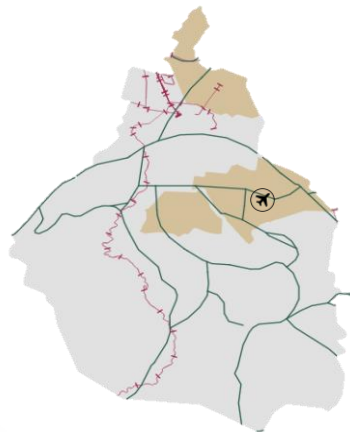

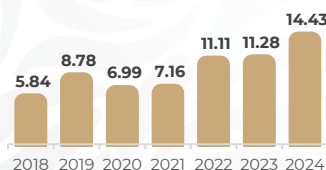

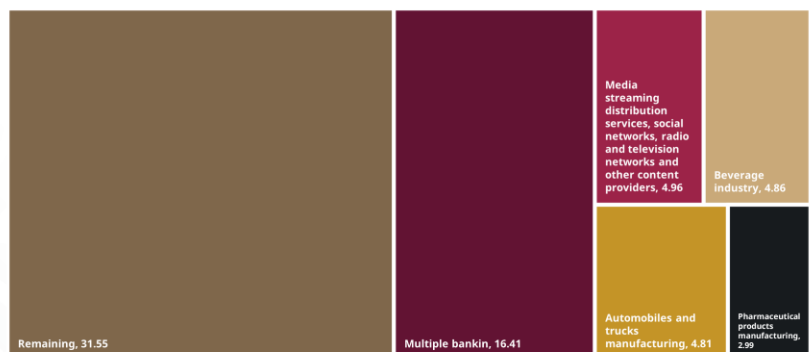
Historic FDI (2018 - 2024)
