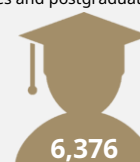

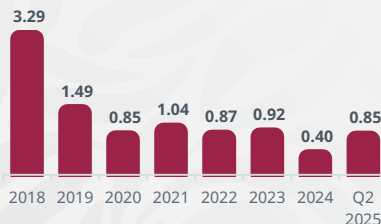

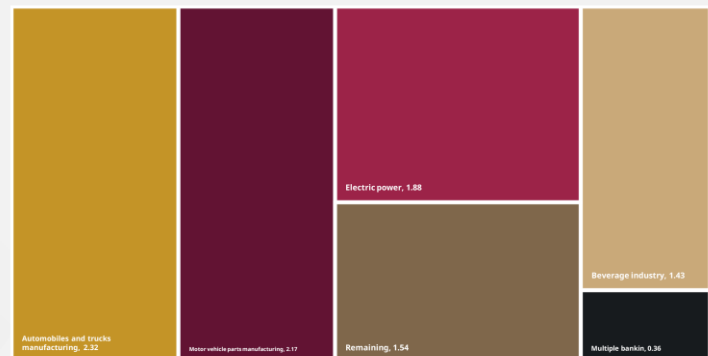
Historic FDI
