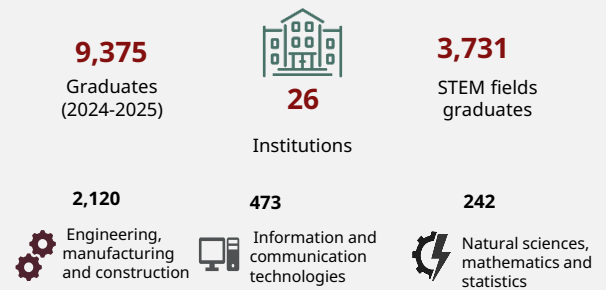

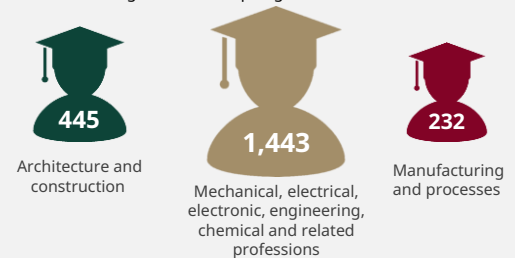
MEXICAN TALENT IN HIGHER EDUCATION

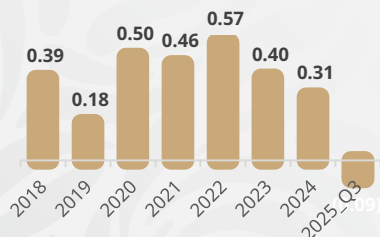

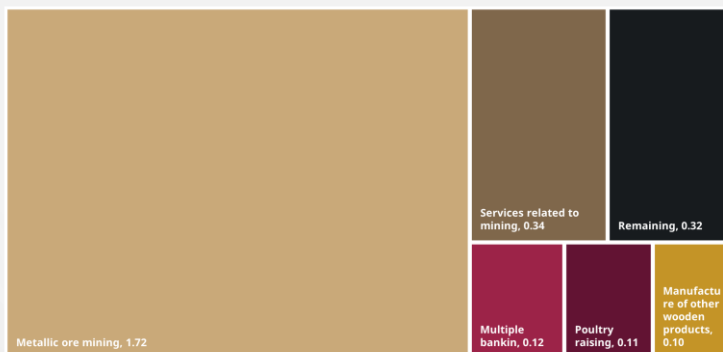
