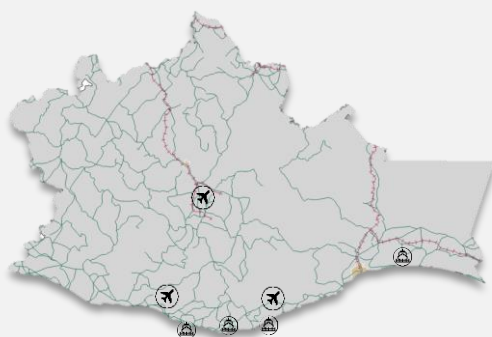

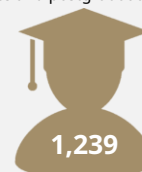

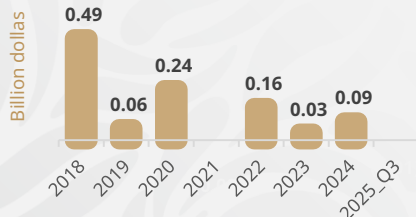

Top 3 by investment origin country

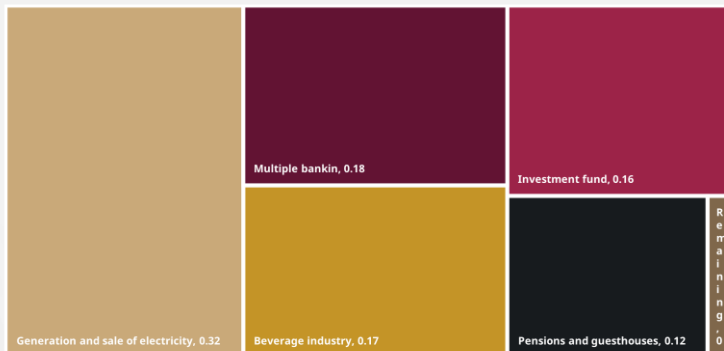
